




Vaccine Data Management and Administration Tracking






Cherokee Nation Health Services

Healthy Cherokee communities

- Largest tribally operated health care system in the United States
- 1.3 million patient visits
- 11 health care facilities and one youth treatment center
- Community, social, mental and public health programs







Our Most Vulnerable Population



- Approximately 2,500 Cherokee
 Speakers worldwide
 - 760 over age 70
 - 138 over age 80
 - 13-15 over age 90
- Prior to the pandemic
 - Losing over 100 speakers annually
- Impact of COVID-19
 - 48 Deaths of Cherokee Speakers

Vaccinating our Transient Patients

- April 2020 started mobile testing for COVID 19 at various mobile testing sites
- Utilized School Health Program van
- Very time-consuming process
 - Unreliable WiFi at locations
 - Manual
- Grant funded
- Testing prepared us for vaccination
- Partnership with Cleveland Public Health
 Department & Cuyahoga County Board of Health
- Mobile health vans
- IT equipment
 - Device packs
- First vaccination clinic Feb 19th: Moderna
 - Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry's Men's Shelter
 - Scheduled 120 people



Following our Mission

How are we doing?

- 120 people scheduled/90 vaccinated
- More than a dozen clinics since 2/19
- Administered 500 first dose to date
- Second dose started 3/19
- 80 people showed for original 90
- Johnson & Johnson vaccines
- Benefits of technology
