






Career Pathways

- Graduate degrees aren't always required for a role but can help set you apart in a competitive field

- Variety of areas outside of hospitals and health clinics: academic institutions, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, software vendors, consulting firms and private practice



The HIT Industry

- Employment of health information technology technicians is projected to grow percent from 2020 to 2030, as fast as average for all occupations
- Employment of medical and health services managers is projected to grow 32 percent from 2020 to 2030, much faster than the average for all occupations
- The demand for health services is expected to increase as the population ages

grasp of the rigorous body of knowledge for digital health transformation strategy.
